Voting – It's Your Right

Election Day is Tuesday November 6, 2012, and along with several voting sites, the District will provide a voting site for those registered to vote at that precinct. The location is the District office at 5000 Sun Valley Blvd., downstairs in the Board Room. The Board Room is accessed by Prosser Avenue. Winter Sewer Evaluation

Each Year the District performs a winter sewer usage evaluation. During the months of December, January and February customers will be billed sewer charges based on 100% of their metered water consumption. This allows the District to set each customer sewer maximum. What does that mean? During these months it is likely that most customers are not irrigating their yards or using additional water that never reaches the District's sewer system (Swamp cooler, washing cars, etc.) It is safe to say that any water use during the evaluation months is an accurate measure of metered water consumption that reaches the District's Sewer

system. The average monthly consumption during this period shall establish each individual customer's maximum monthly billable quantity for sewer service for the remainder of the year (March-November). If the monthly discharge is less than the average monthly consumption, the billing shall be based on the actual metered water consumption for that billing period. If at any time during the winter sewer usage evaluation period you experience a leak, drip your water to prevent the pipes from freezing, or irrigate the yard due to unseasonably warm weather, please contact the District to fill out the appropriate form. Submitting these forms will allow the District to take these instances into consideration when setting the sewer maximum.
