CONSERVING WATER

The District requests voluntary three times a week watering. Lawns thrive, it saves water and money. Odd addresses water on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. Even addresses water Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. Please don't water between 1 pm and 5 pm. It is the hottest part of the day and water evaporates and doesn't reach the lawn or plant's root system. Watering on windy days causes too much evaporation and can waste up to 300 gallons in one watering. Mulching around your trees and plants can save 750 to 1,500 gallons per month.
