DROUGHT UPDATE/CONSERVATION

With another year of lower than normal precipitation in the Truckee Meadows and a reduced snowpack in the Sierra, residents have brought forth concerns regarding drought and the availability of water. The District receives its water from the Truckee Meadows Water Authority. The main source of water comes from the Truckee River which flows from Lake Tahoe to Pyramid Lake. TMWA also has over thirty ground water wells used to supplement the Truckee River source to meet peak summertime demands. At this time the District has not received notice of any proposed restrictions to water use for our customers. As always we continue to support water conservation and responsible water use to our customers. With the knowledge of the current water situation we highly encourage all of our customers to participate in the established voluntary watering day schedule. The District will keep its website updated with current information on any water restrictions.

- **Even addresses: Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**
- **Odd addresses: Wednesday, Friday and Sunday**

Avoid watering between noon and 6 p.m. You can hand water your gardens and plants any day of the week.
