The District awarded Resource Development Company with the bid for the construction of a new Pump Station and rehab of the Juniper Terrace Water Tank, as identified in the District's Water Master Plan Capital Improvement Outlay. These two projects are scheduled for completion in June of 2019. It is important to note that all Capital Improvement Projects are paid for by the rate payers. And in addition, the District Trustees act fiscally responsible when approving all Capital Improvement Projects for Sun Valley.
