SUN VALLEY BLVD PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The RTC has been busy updating and beautifying Sun Valley Blvd. The RTC project is aimed to improve the pedestrian experience in the Valley. The Project will include: Two new pedestrian-activated rapid flashing beacon crossings at Quartz Lane and Middle Fork Drive; Dedicated



left-turn lane from northbound Sun Valley Blvd to Staci Way; Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements; New sidewalks and bike lanes; Drainage improvements; New pavement; An upgraded traffic signal at Sun Valley Boulevard/7th Street and a reconfiguration of the intersection to improve safety and Aesthetic improvements.

TARIFF HEARING
