#### **RULE NO. 3**

#### APPLICATION FOR SERVICE AND GENERAL MATTERS

#### I. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

#### A. Contents:

Each Applicant for water and/or sewer service shall be required to sign, on a form provided by the District, an application which will set forth:

- 1. Applicant name and service address
- 2. Service type (residential or commercial)
- 3. Requested service start date
- 4. Address to which bills are to be mailed or delivered.
- 5. Whether Applicant is the landowner of the premises
- 6. How many units are served from this meter
- 7. Provide photo identification with signature issued by the state and/or county and other information as the District may reasonably require.

### B. <u>Effect Of Application:</u>

The application, or the deposit of any sum of money by the Applicant, shall not require the District to render service until the expiration of such time as may be reasonably required by the District to determine if Applicant has complied with the provisions of the District Rules and/or Regulations and as may reasonably be required by the District to install the required service facilities.

# C. <u>Purpose:</u>

The application is merely a written request for service and does not bind the Applicant to take service for a minimum period. Neither does it bind the District to provide service. ## II. SPECIAL CASES

The District will require a written contract with special guarantee from Applicants whose unusual characteristics of water and/or sewer load would require excessive investment in facilities or whose requirements for service are of a special nature.

## III. WAIVER OF FEES, CHARGES, ETC.

In the event the District determines that a customer which does not, because of legal exemption, pay real property taxes has in the past, or will in the future, provide other consideration or services to the District, which consideration or service is substantially equal to or greater than the money to be derived from the fees, charges or deposits provided for in the District Rules and/or Regulations if paid by such customer, the Board may, in its discretion, waive such Customer's payment of any such fees, charges or deposits set out in any Rule in the District Rules and/or Regulations.
