

Rental Assistance Program

The Emergency Rental Assistance Program serves residents of Washoe County experiencing financial hardship due directly or indirectly to COVID-19.

May be used for current or past-due utility bills

Eligibility:

Must be a resident of Washoe County.

Must be able to provide proof of status as a renter.

Maximum household income at or below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI) with preference being given to households with income at or below 50% AMI.

Preference also being given to households with one or more members being unemployed for more than 90 days.

Households must be able to demonstrate the financial impact of COVID-19 on their households.

The households must demonstrate a risk of homelessness or housing instability.
