What to bring:

APPLIANCES Dishwashers, stoves, microwave ovens, garbage disposals, ovens, washing machines, clothes dryers, automobile batteries, and *refrigerators, *freezers, *air conditioners. ***must be free from Freon.**

ELECTRONICS Keyboards, mice, computers, laptops, printers, cell phones, radios, stereos, phones, dvd/vcr players, cd players, clocks, *computer monitors, *televitions, etc. **Two FREE TV's or two monitors or one of each per household, \$20 for each additional tv and/or monitor.**

What NOT to bring:

Liquids, toner cartridges, HAZARDOUS MATERIAL, anything leaking fluids and tires, TV's or computer monitors with cracked or broken screens, medical supplies.
